The Lions football team came from behind to beat Dartmouth in dramatic fashion at this year's Homecoming game at Robert K. Kraft Field. Battling rain and forty-mile-per-hour wind gusts, freshman place kicker Oren Milstein hit three field goals, including the game-winner, scoring with one minute to go in the third quarter to lift Columbia 9-7. The Lions defense then held firm, stopping the Big Green on their last drive, which ended when their placekicker missed a field goal with just twenty-seven seconds left in the game.
