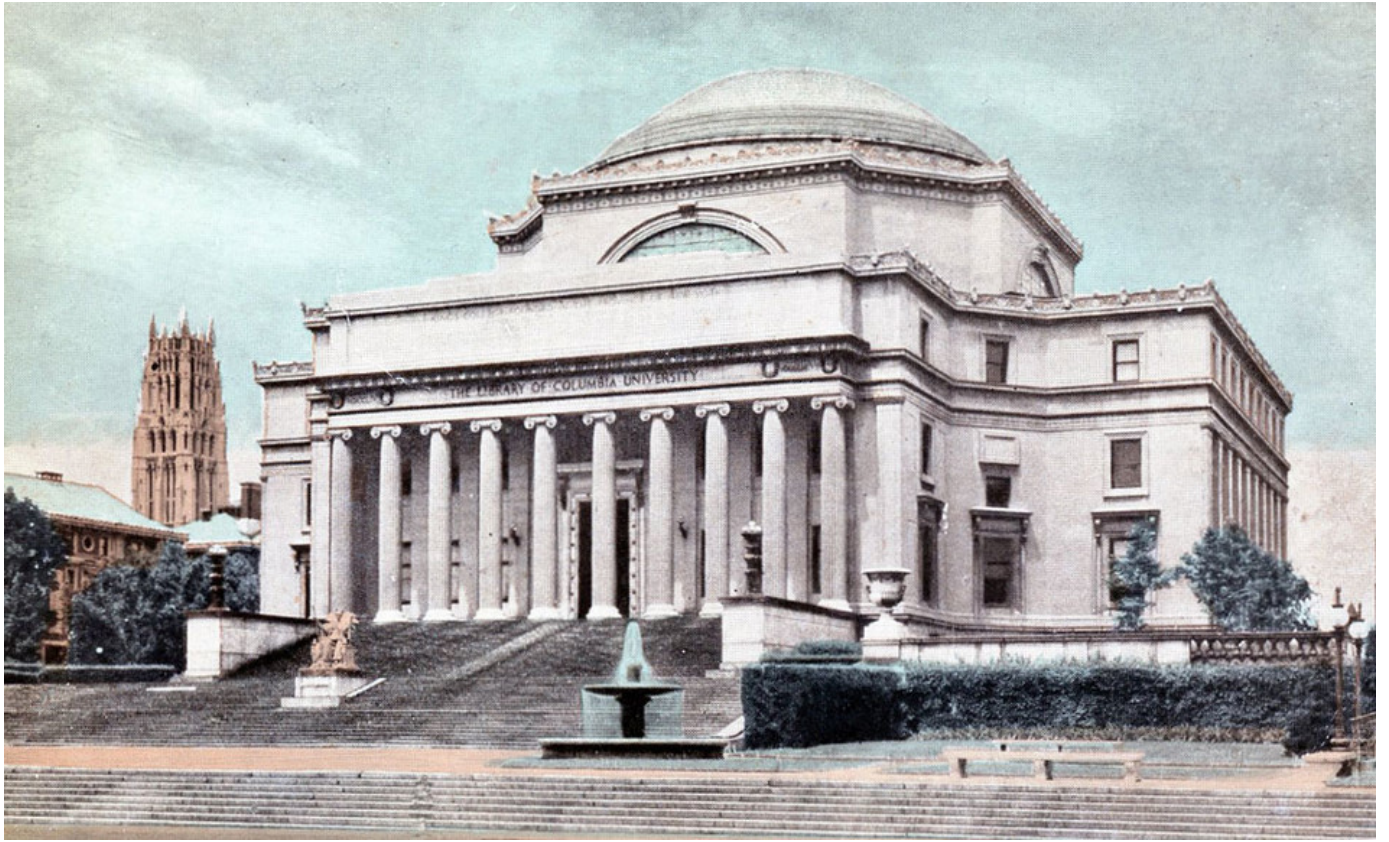

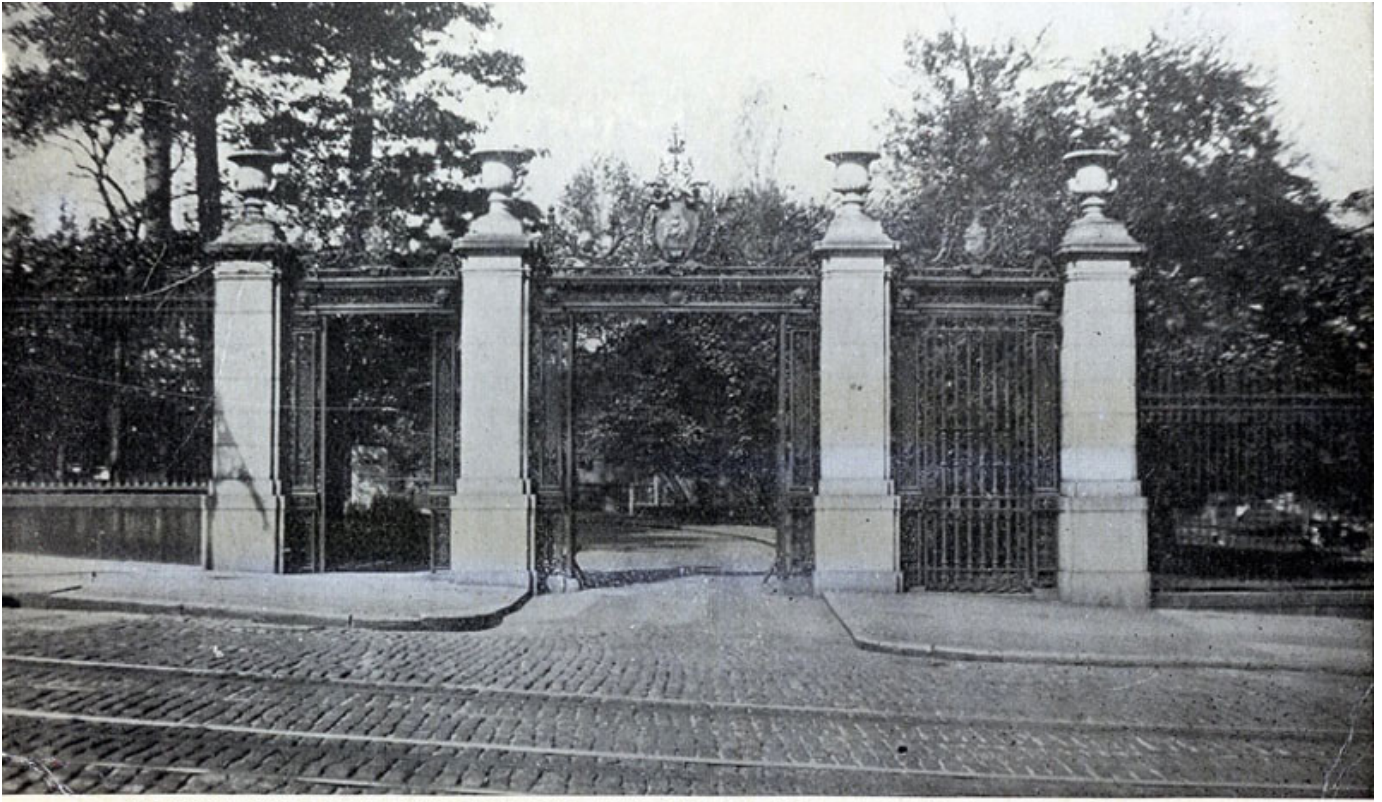

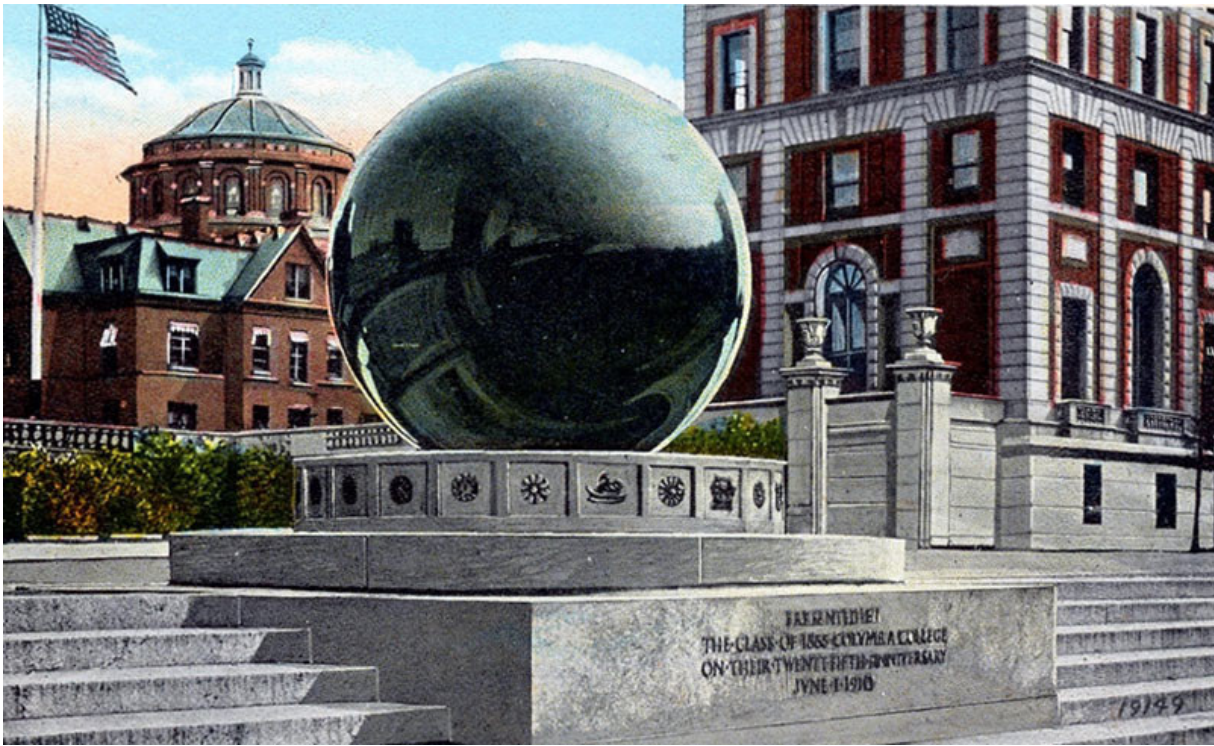

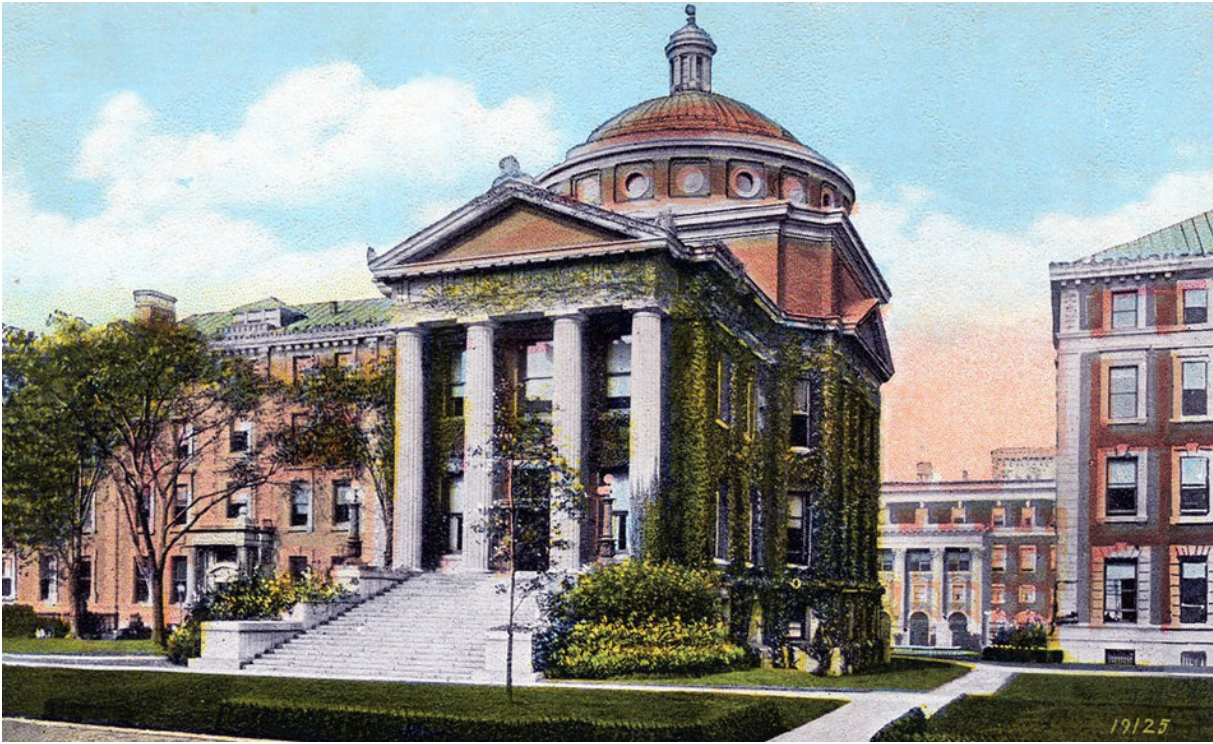

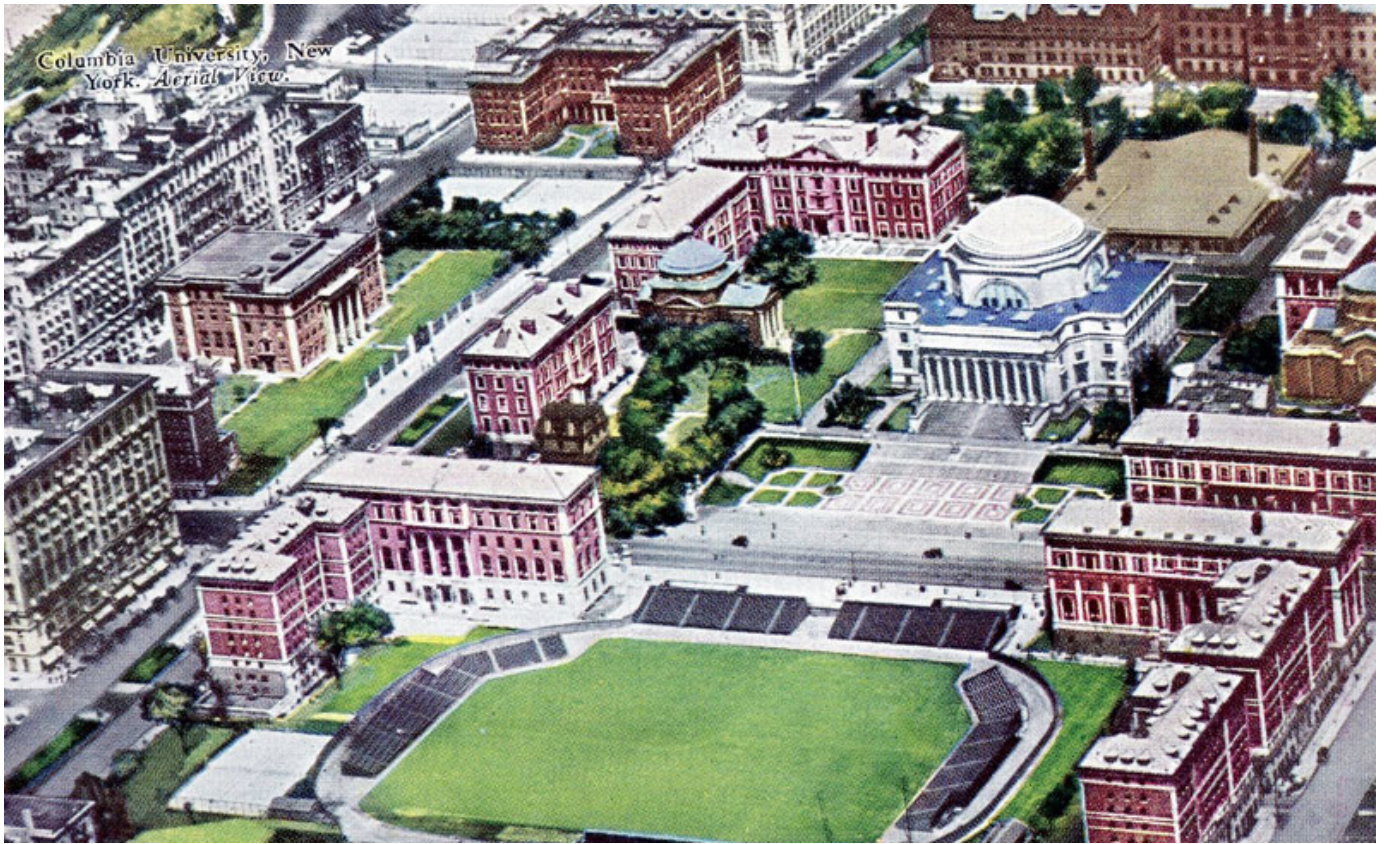

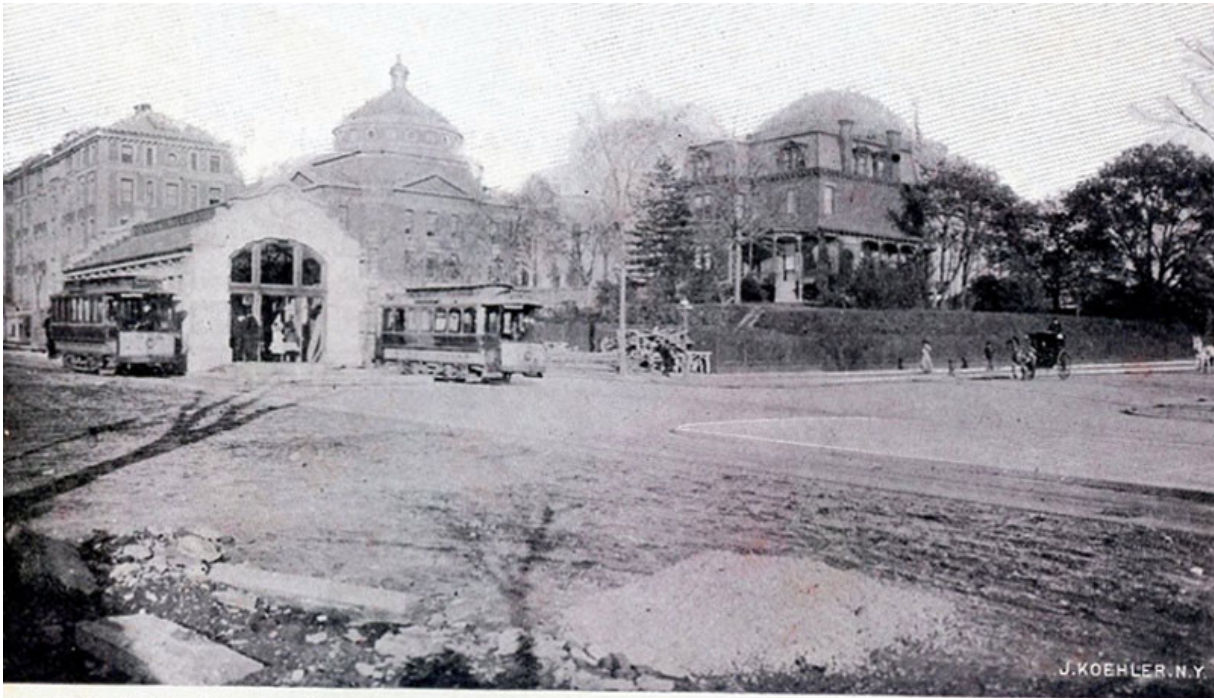

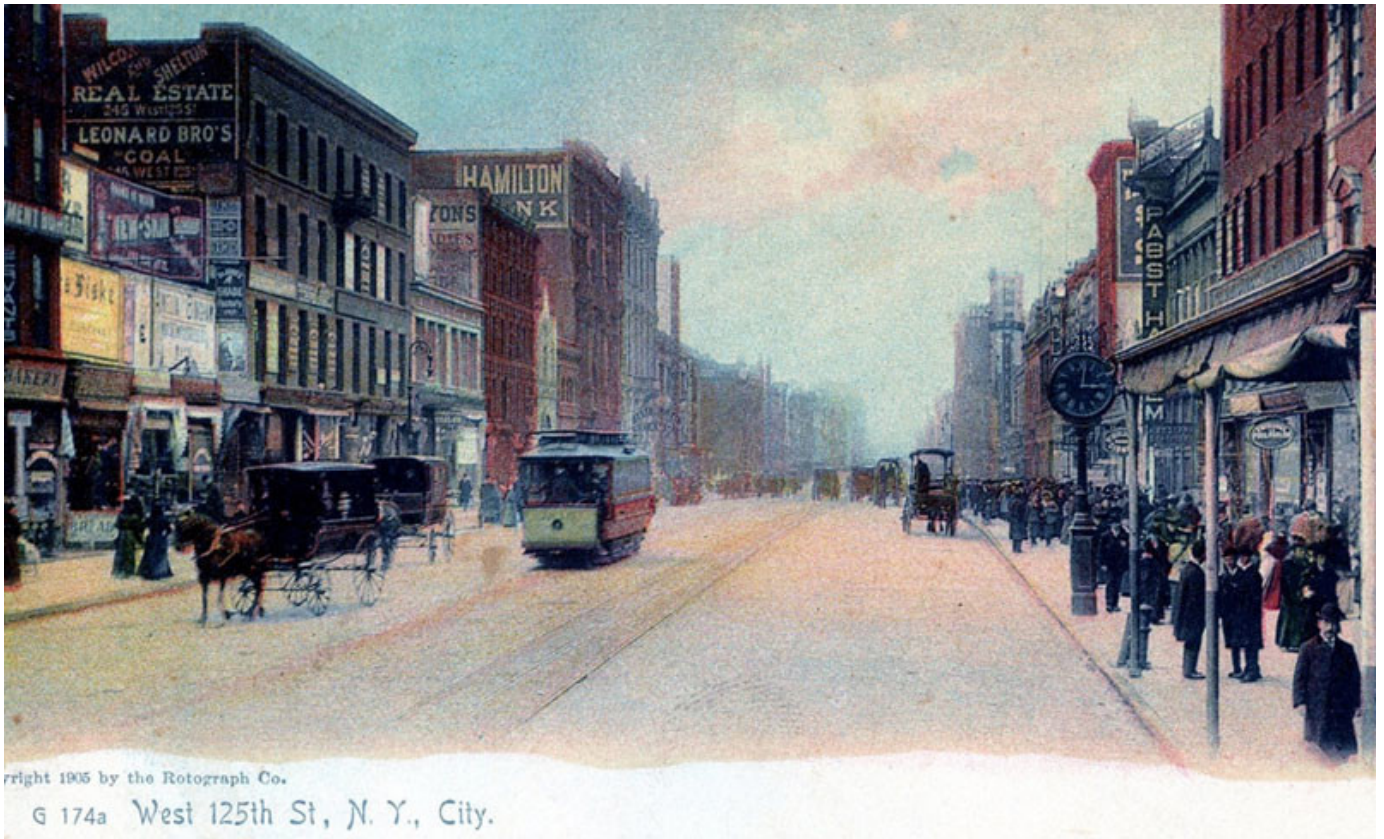


Elevated R. R. Curve at 110th Street, New York.
